As a regional affiliate of the American Educational Research Association, NERA invites proposals for workshops for our annual meeting that appeal to quantitative/measurement researchers, qualitative researchers, graduate students, and educators as researchers. We welcome proposals from current NERA members as well as non-NERA members. This year's conference theme is:

## "Where do we go from here? Shaping the future of education together"

We encourage proposals that answer the question *Where do we go from here?* And address how educational researchers can help *shape the future of education together*. Additionally, we encourage proposals that critically reflect on what "together" means and examine issues through a diversity, equity, inclusion, and justice (DEIJ) lens. Although a connection to the conference theme is desired, it is not a requirement for proposal submissions.

#### **Workshop Proposal Submission Requirements**

- Name, affiliation, and email address of workshop presenter(s)
- Descriptive workshop title (maximum: 15 words) and three keywords
- Short description of workshop to appear in conference program (maximum: 100 words)
- Longer description of workshop including learning objectives, target audience, format, and presenter's background/qualifications that relate to the workshop (maximum: 1000 words)
- Expected workshop length (1 hour and 30 minutes, 2 hours, or 3 hours)

Proposals must be submitted via Google Form by **Tuesday, May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2023** (11:59pm EST) https://tinyurl.com/NERA23workshop

#### **Submission Review Process**

- All NERA members will have an opportunity to vote on the short description of each workshop proposal (presenters' names will be removed from descriptions).
- The short descriptions will be sent to NERA members and selections made based on members' interest; no specific criteria will be given.
  - o Please keep this in mind when writing workshop descriptions.

- o By allowing the NERA membership to vote on the most desired workshop topics, we are ensuring that there will be optimal attendance at the workshops during the conference.
- Next, the conference chairs will select workshops based on votes and topics addressed to provide a balance of offerings.
- Workshop proposal decisions will be emailed by July 15<sup>th</sup>. Details about workshop session dates and times will follow when the program is finalized late summer.
- Please note: Although you do not have to be a member to propose a workshop, you must become a member if your workshop proposal is accepted to present at the NERA annual conference.
